MULTIPLE FABRIC:

Should you request multiple fabrics on a single item, a Multiple Fabric Diagram must be supplied to Customer Service prior to the order being entered for production. Please contact Customer Service for the appropriate form.

ModuForm's Graded-In Fabric Program

ModuForm offers a "graded-in" fabric program to streamline the textile selection process. While we collaborate with fabric mills and suppliers, specifications and textile availability may change without notice. ModuForm conducts tests to evaluate the strength and performance of "graded-in" textiles; however, we cannot guarantee that all fabrics will meet the necessary criteria for manufacturing at all times.

If a "graded-in" textile purchased through ModuForm requires additional steps—such as backing or seam tape—to ensure it can be cut, stitched, and upholstered to our specifications, additional charges may apply.

CUSTOMER'S OWN MATERIAL (COM):

Upholstered products may be ordered using customer-provided fabric or vinyl (COM). Fees are listed in the most recent Price List under the "COM" column and cover only the product and labor for fabric application. Only upholstery-grade textiles will be accepted. COM yardage estimates are based on 54" wide, plain textiles (measured between the selvedge edges) with no pattern repeat.

A "COM Data Sheet" (see next page) must accompany a fabric memo sample and related specifications for each selected material. This should be submitted with your purchase order. For reversible fabrics, clearly mark the exposed side. Upon receiving the memo sample, ModuForm will assess whether the fabric is suitable for upholstering within our processing steps. Customer Service will notify you of approval or rejection, along with any necessary next steps.

Once approved, all fabric must be shipped to ModuForm (address above), freight pre-paid, in continuous yards from the same dye lot, and backed prior to arrival. ModuForm is not responsible for delivery delays or fabric inspection. Manufacturing will not begin until the COM is received. If additional steps—such as backing or seam taping—are required, production will pause until added charges are approved.

ModuForm does not warrant or assess COM fabric performance or compliance with local life-safety or building codes. We are not responsible for tailoring issues, seam slippage, appearance, durability, fading, pattern matching, or overall fabric performance. Given the variety of cleaning agents and environmental factors, we recommend testing each fabric with the intended cleaning products.
